March 4th Class - Lola's Pencil Case

Date: March 4, 2023 (First Saturday in March)

Teacher: Kelly Stevens

Location: Richlands First Christian Church - 124 Trott Rd, Richlands, NC 28574

Time: 9:30-4:00 (Doors open at 9:00AM)

Cost: \$10

Supplies needed:

- 1 9x12 exterior main fabric
- 1-9x12 interior fabric
- 1 -9x12 accent fabric (accent strip, handle)
- 1 9x12 piece of foam (Pellon, Bosal, or soft and stable)
- 1-14" of longer zipper

The zipper needs to be a byAnnie zipper, or a #5 zipper. The width should be 1.5" wide. The small dress zippers will not work!

Thread to match fabric

Supplies needed:

- Neutral thread
- pins
- rotary cutter
- small cutting mat
- sewing machine and usual supplies
- a stiletto, purple thang, or wooden skewer
- one white on white fat quarter
- various colored fabric for the animals should be at least a 7"square
