What a great start we had at January Sew Day, sewing over 200 Christmas Stockings for our Community Mission for Elder Cheer. Let's continue in this Community Endeavor.

This past year, the Carolina Pine Needle Quilters Guild provided 300 plus quilts to One Place Child Advocacy Center. This is another main guild mission. Child Abuse is a community issue. Carolina Pine Needle Quilters Guild has been involved with One Place Child Advocacy Center for over a decade. The guild makes quilts of all sizes to provide a "Portable Hug" for ages birth to 18 years. The quilts the children receive at the center stay with the abuse victims forever, a token of hope and love to help them through the rough times.





To get us started, several 3 yard quilt kits have been cut and are ready to assemble on February Sew Day. Your great sewing skills can help provide the quilt tops needed for Child Advocacy Center. Lots of different patterns will be available to sew and cut. If you are new to quilting, this is a fabulous opportunity to learn the basic skills of making a throw quilt. Mentors will be available for you. You are welcome to bring 3 coordinating one yard fabric cuts and we will gladly help you follow the cutting instructions too,

45 MM ROTARY CUTTER AND SMALL CUTTING MAT

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

PLEASE, IF POSSIBLE, HAVE ALL THESE PIECES PRECUT BEFORE THE DAY OF CLASS TREE: CUT (38) 5" SQUARES. THIS IS FOR THE MAIN BODY OF THE TREE. VARIETY OF

GREEN SHADES IS GOOD.

STAR: (2) 5 ½" SQUARES OF GOLD FABRIC. YOU CAN USE ANY COLOR OF YOUR CHOICE.

BACKGROUND FABRIC: (2) 4" BY 7 ½ " PIECES

(9) 4 ½" BY 7 ½"; PIECES (2) 11 INCH SQUARES,

(2) 4 BY 11 INCH RECTANGLES, (2) 7 1½ INCH SQUARES,

AND (2) 2 ½ BY 5 INCH RECTANGLES.

TREE TRUNK: CUT (2) 2 ½" BY 5 INCH BROWN PIECES. POINT OF CONTACT: SUE MILLER 910-389-0862

Hosted by Crystal Coast Quilters' Guild and Croatan Quilt Guild

Join us on March 23, 2024, at On the Rocks Restaurant, Atlantic Beach (across from Doubletree) for a day of fun, food, party favors, door prizes, Challenge quilt display and awards, and quilts, quilts, and more quilts. <u>The cost is only \$15.</u>

Special Guest Speaker will be Lynn Lancaster Gorges. Awesome prizes to be awarded!

Show and Tell will be limited to ONE item only per person. Please provide a brief description of your item on a 3"x5" index card. Index cards will be available at check-in.

CCQG will have a Charity Raffle quilt that will be given away on this day. Tickets will be \$2 each or 3 for \$5. Proceeds from the ticket sales will be donated to Katey's Kits, a community organization that collects, purchases and supplies feminine hygiene products in Carteret and surrounding counties to young women who are experiencing period poverty.
